Totus Tuus, Maria. Personal Consecration to Our Lady Following the Spiritual Teaching of St Louis-Marie Grignion de Montfort

May 25 2020 Pope St John Paul II chose Totus Tuus as his apostolic motto. A Latin phrase meaning 'totally yours', it expressed his personal Consecration to Mary, based on the spiritual teaching of Saint Louis-Marie Grignion de Montfort and the Mariology of his writings. The saintly pontiff defined it as an expression of piety but also of devotion, deeply rooted in the Mystery of the Blessed Trinity. St Louis-Marie Grignion de Montfort showed that there is a sure, quick, and easy way that leads to Jesus Christ; this way is Mary. In Totus Tuus, Maria, commissioned by the Institutum Marianum of Regensburg (IMR) and first published in German in 2002, Mgr Florian Kolffhaus recovers the intention of St Louis-Marie Grignion de Montfort, and presents it to the readers of our day and age in a timely fashion. This text invites the reader to follow this path to sanctity. It does not require simply to be read, but it needs to be prayed and meditated on in order to lead, step by step, to the consecration to Mary. Whoever offers himself up to Mary through this consecration to her, seeks shelter under the protective mantle of the Virgin, as Jesus Christ Himself did, and tries to model his life according to her example of charity and love of

God. Is there something more perfect that we can do in our earthly life and for our eternal salvation? The reader will then become part of the communion of those whom the book presents in nine short biographies: the saints. Saints, like Pope St John Paul II, who have found the fullness of life in Jesus Christ through consecration to Mary.

The Consecration to Jesus through Mary, which he taught, was meant as a perfect renewal of the baptismal vows. Saying this, Louis-Marie holds the view that mysticism is meant for everyone, since it is the ordinary flowering of baptismal grace through the practice of faith, hope and charity.

He was known in his time as a preacher and was made a missionary apostolic by Pope Clement XI. As well as preaching, Montfort found time to write a number of books which went on to become classic Catholic titles and influenced several popes. Montfort is known for his particular devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary and the practice of praying the Rosary. Montfort is considered as one of the early writers in the field of Mariology. His most notable works regarding Marian devotions are contained in *The Secret of Mary* and *The True Devotion to Mary*. The Roman Catholic Church, under the pontificate of Pope Pius XII canonized Montfort on July 20, 1947. Those of you looking to know our Heavenly Mother Mary better and to consecrate yourselves to Her service will find an abundant source of treasure within these books. The Holy Rosary is explained and how it can be used to fight satan in these times. Also explained is the mystery of suffering and the cross. The Secret of Mary Jan 13 2022 Secret of Mary is a book by Saint Louis de Montfort on the Roman Catholic theme of devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. It complements de Montfort's other books the Secret of the Rosary and True Devotion to Mary. Saint Louis de Montfort's books attracted attention in the 20th century when in an address to the Montfortian Fathers, Pope John Paul II said that reading one of de Montfort's books had been a "decisive turning point" in his life.

The Spiritual Life in the School of St. Louis-Marie Grignon de Montfort Nov 11 2021 When *La vie spirituelle* appeared in 1901, it was the first book that delved into the dogmatic and ascetic underpinnings of St. Louis-Marie's two well-known works, *True Devotion to the Blessed Virgin* and *The Secret of Mary*; the first, that is, 200 years after they were written, and 60 years after they were discovered. In his preface, Fr. Antonin Lhoumeau says that "many have written on the devotion to the Blessed Virgin, called the Holy Slavery of Mary; but none has yet shown with consistency and to a great extent, that it is, according to the

teachings of St. Louis-Marie, a system of spirituality, a special form of interior life, and not merely a set of pious practices." Fr. Lhoumeau's aim was to fill the gap in the understanding of the devotion to our Blessed Mother, and he succeeds very well indeed. In his 1902 review, Jean-Baptiste Terrien, the renowned Jesuit professor at the Institut Catholique de Paris, wrote: "All those who have at heart the glory of their Blessed Mother and the great business of their perfection in Christ, will have the pleasure and will gain edification by reading this book." THE AUTHOR: The Most Rev. Antonin Lhomeau (1852-1920), was the Superior General of the Company of Mary and the Daughters of Wisdom, the twelfth, after St. Louis-Marie, its founder. Fr. Lhoumeau founded several journals for the diffusion of the teachings of St. Louis-Marie. Besides the current title, he has two other works on Marian spirituality. Fr. Lhoumeau, a brilliant and cultivated soul, was also an accomplished musician and musicologist, who wrote several studies on Gregorian chant and hymn books. He died in 1920 and is buried in Saint-Laurent-sur-Sèvre in France.
