infinitely differentiable with compact support, then there are other objects with the same shape, i. e. , support, which can differ almost arbitrarily and still have the same projections in finitely many directions. On the other hand, he proved that objects in finite dimensional function spaces are uniquely determined by a single projection for almost 11 angles, i. e. , except on a set of measure zero. Along these lines, Herman and Rowland in [41] showed that reconstructions obtained from the commonly used algorithms can grossly misrepresent the object and that the algorithm which produced the best

reconstruction when using noiseless data gave unsatisfactory results with noisy data. Equally important are reports in Science, [67, 68] and personal communications by radiologists indicating that in medical practice failure rates of reconstruction vary from four to twenty percent.
