In chapter three, I am going to talk about the speaking activity the class will be doing during the approach of *Wuthering Heights* to get a better connection to its story and make the students speak about it. During the explanation of the activity in chapter three I will first talk about the aims of it explicitly, second describe the whole preparation phase, third the activity itself in its performance and fourth I will have a reflection on the activity and its possible application in class with its faults and potency.
