The growing concern over the number of accidental firearm shootings, especially those involving children, prompted passage of the initial handgun safety law which went into effect in 1994. The stated intent of the California Legislature in enacting the current FSC law is for persons who obtain firearms to have a basic familiarity with those firearms, including, but not limited to, the safe handling and storage of those firearms. The statutory authority for this program is contained in Penal Code sections 26840 and 31610 through 31700. These statutes mandate DOJ to develop, implement and maintain the FSC Program. Pursuant to Penal Code section 26840, a firearms dealer cannot deliver a firearm unless the person receiving the firearm presents a valid FSC, which is obtained by passing a written test on firearm safety. Prior to taking delivery of a firearm from a licensed firearms dealer, the purchaser/recipient must also successfully perform a safe handling demonstration with that firearm.. Chapter 4 brings up some of the terms that are common with concealed weapon permits. These include the differences between shall issue and may issue states and even the areas that don't allow concealed weapons at all. Chapter 5 splits up each state, as well as Washington, D.C. and talks about their concealed weapon permit regulations. These are going to vary; some will be shall issue and make it easy to get the permit if you follow the requirements they lay out, some don't even require a permit, and some areas make it almost impossible to get a concealed carry permit. We will take a look at all of the states and some of their basic requirements to get this permit. Chapter 6 finishes out the guidebook with some of the legal issues that have come up throughout the years concerning concealed carry. There are a lot of questions that come up with concealed carry and whether it should be handled by the states or the federal government.
